

Greetings,

You are receiving this letter because you indicated that you had a hot tub in your Cross Connection Survey. As far as Cross Connection Control is concerned, there are two types of hot tubs: Those that connect to the water system and those do not because they are self-contained.

Hot tubs that are <u>not</u> connected to the public water supply obviously pose <u>no risk</u> of backflowing chemical-filled water into our drinking water. **PLEASE, IF YOU FILL WITH A HOSE, NEVER SUBMERGE THE HOSE-END IN THE WATER.** This creates an immediate cross connection.

<u>Automatically filling hot tubs</u> - Those that maintain their own water level <u>could be a risk</u> if not properly protected with a backflow preventer.

This is why it is important that you ascertain the type of hot tub that you have, indicate it on the return portion of this letter and send it back to me.

Please return this via mail, scanning and emailing or in person no later than **30 days** after the receipt of this letter.
