2021 Special Meeting Background



COVID Restrictions Impact

- COVID-19 Restrictions issued in March 2020 prevented holding the 2020 Annual meeting elections in April as required.
- To provide ongoing management of the association the BOD passed a resolution extending the terms of the four directors positions due for elections in 2020, which was in an even year.
- The Bylaws state that at the 2021 Annual Meeting we would be required to have the remaining three director positions up for election, as it is an odd year.

Director Election Options



The Board of Directors considered the following 3 Options.... At the 2021 Annual Membership Meeting we could ...

- A Hold a Special Meeting just before the 2021 Annual meeting, to vote on changing the bylaws so that going forward, the four Director positions are elected in odd years, and three Director positions and Treasurer positions are elected in even years; or
- **B** Hold elections for the Treasurer, and the three Directors originally designated for 2021 elections, and extend the 4 Director positions due for elections in 2020, to 2022; or
- **C** Hold elections for all 7 Directors and the Treasurer roles at the 2021 Annual Meeting.

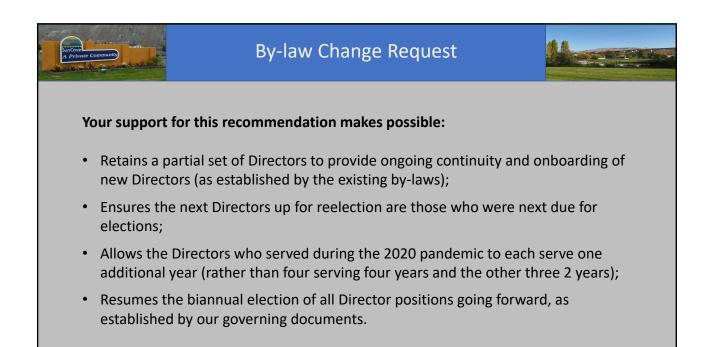


Board Recommendation



Option A: Change Article II, Section 4 of the By-Laws as shown below.

The Board of Directors shall consist of seven (7) members elected by the membership to serve two (2) year terms. In the odd year, three (3) four (4) Directors will leave the Board. In even years, four (4) three (3) Directors will leave the Board. The Board of Directors will elect the President and Vice President from individuals on the Board. All other Board members will be considered Members-at-Large. The Secretary and Treasurer will be elected by the members and shall serve two year terms. All Board members and the Secretary and Treasurer may succeed themselves if re-elected by the Association members at the end of their two year period of office.

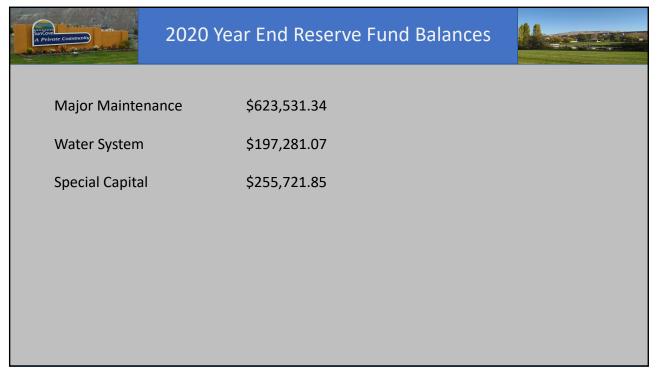

- 3. Five members of our community



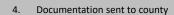
Covenants Review



Process

Once a draft set of covenants was agreed on:

- 1. Sent out "Covenant Amendment Survey"
 - A. Current covenant
 - B. Recommended change
 - C. Summary of, and reasons for, change
- 2. Survey results were tabulated
 - A. Covenants with >30 disagreement:
 - Discussed, changed or not changed
 - B. These were sent out for additional comments
 - C. Covenant proposal finalized
- 3. Proposed covenants sent out
 - Need 50% +1 members to approve
 - Total members = 439, i.e. 220 + 1 = 221
 - 260 responded
 - 233 positively, 27 negatively

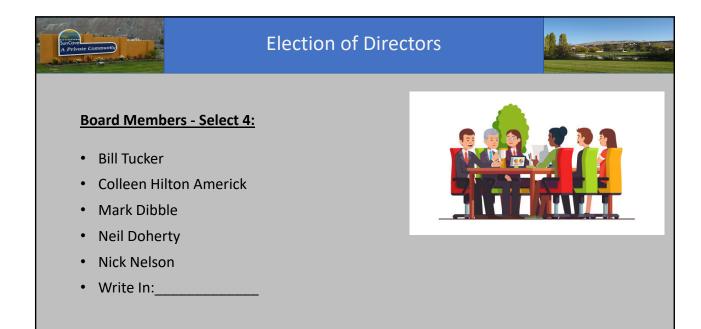

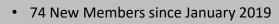

- Currently focused on the first 8 of 25 planned homes, each on one acre lots.
- A 25-35 room hotel will sit on the ridge overlooking the waterfront section and include a restaurant and likely a spa.
